Types of services:

1. **Informational and Educational Programs** – Seminars, lectures, and workshops are organized for students and faculty members to raise awareness about reproductive health and its importance.
2. **Medical Counseling** – The university's medical center provides expert advice on reproductive health, family planning, and preventive measures.
3. **Psychological Support** – Students can receive personal and confidential counseling from university psychologists.
4. **Promotion of Healthy Lifestyles** – Information about maintaining health, proper nutrition, and disease prevention is disseminated among students.
5. **Social Projects and Awareness Campaigns** – The university organizes various events to increase awareness of sexual and reproductive health.

AI Medical Ambulatory Doctors and Nurses Obtained BLS Certification

On December 9, 2024, a seminar-training session was held at the university's Faculty of Medicine to enhance the qualifications of specialists. The session focused on **Basic Life Support (BLS)** skills, with a duration of 6 hours. This training cycle aimed to provide essential skills for emergency medical assistance.

December 1 - World AIDS Day

On December 1, in recognition of World AIDS Day, the university organized an event in the dormitories under the theme "Choose the Right Path." Specialists from the regional HIV prevention center participated in the event and discussed the global and local spread of HIV infection, the epidemiological situation, and the social protection of people living with HIV. They also provided insights into stigma and discrimination.

At the end of the event, a feedback session was held with students, where a Q&A discussion took place. The purpose of the event was to provide students with accurate information about HIV infection, teach them safe behavioral practices, and promote respect for the rights of people living with HIV.
